This is a group-based curricula for parents and families who have infants, one-year-olds and two-year-olds. Parents come together for 10 sessions beginning Feb. 21, 2011 at the Jackson County Family Resource Center in Webster. The classes will run every Monday from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm. The classes are free and also provide supper at 5:30 pm with free child care provided.
